

SAINT-VERAN VIEILLES VIGNES

Grape variety: Chardonnay

Yield and density: Yields are 56hl hectares, there are 8,000 hectares.

Age of the vine: 75-year-old.

Terroirs and locations: Saint-Claude. The first terroir is facing southeast, it has an altitude of 250 meters. The ground is clay-limestone.

Cultivation mode: Reasoned control, weeding, ground working.

Grape harvest: Manual grape harvest and pressing of whole bunches.

Fermentation: Fermentation in barrels for one to seven years + a part in vats.
The assembly is done 1 month before the bottling these wines on 10 months of breeding.

Tasting: Fresh complex notes with also fresh vanilla notes.

Food and wine: It can perfectly be associated with lobster with citrus butter, white boudin (pudding), and also an oysters gratin.
